Completed applications should be sent to apply@ifusionfoundation.org with all required documentation attached to same email, with your full name and “Computer Application” in the subject line. Please note that as we have limited quantities, we can only select a limited number of applicants.

Applicants must show that they can use the computer to create a “ripple effect” in their family and/or community. The “ripple effect” is the main mission of the iFusionFoundation, and means that we seek to create ripples of positive change and impact through our donation programs and grants.

Step Six—Application Submission

Step Seven—Screening and Approval
